## RULES FOR INCLUSIVE SPORT AWARDS

### PROMIS ASSOCIATION PROGRAM

1. Eligible for this award are sports clubs, sports sections of associations, associations or organizations supporting inclusive sports, foundations, municipalities, amateur or professional athletes and individuals who practice, perform or develop initiatives or programs in the field of inclusive sports.

2. The award will be given to initiatives that demonstrate an impact on the society they influence in each of the categories, and also enhance human rights and inclusive sport values such as effort, respect, commitment, perseverance and social cohesion through initiatives that proactively promote behaviors and conditions for people of diverse origins, identities, gender, age and/or abilities to feel welcome, respected and with a sense of belonging. For the case that applies, the history of organizing events and programs with an emphasis on inclusive sport in the period between **January 2023 and March 2024** will be taken into account.

3. The Inclusive Sport Awards will award 1 prize for each of the 4 categories in competition: In addition to 1 autonomic recognition and 1 national recognition and 1 international recognition, the jury may also award other special prizes or recognitions out of competition.

### EVALUATION GUIDELINES

In the left column of each table are the evaluation criteria for each of the projects according to their category and in the right column the score. The criteria are qualitative but to make the evaluation easier a score from 0 to 100 points will be requested, where 100 is the maximum number of points a criterion can have.



The winner of each category will be the project that obtains the highest number of points resulting from the sum of the points for each of the criteria.

In the event of a tie between the highest scoring projects in each category, the winning project will be selected based on the criteria of the chairman of the Awards Jury.

### **Categories and Criteria – Inclusive Sport Awards**

**1- SOCIAL INTEGRATION AND INTERCULTURALITY:** Initiatives, entities or individuals that promote and support the participation of people of different origins, and that maintain a continuous experience of integration among immigrants and refugees regardless of their documentary and national situation with sport as the central axis, will be recognized.

**Criteria to be evaluated:** diversity of nationalities and ethnicity in the teams, campaigns to promote the values of integration and interculturality, respect and dignity of all human beings regardless of their origin or migratory status, initiatives with the participation of people in a situation of refuge or asylum, among others.

**2- ADAPTED SPORT:** Initiatives, entities or individuals that promote and support the participation in sports of people with disabilities will be recognized, as well as the promotion of adapted sports and the implementation of values such as inclusion, respect and dignity.

**Criteria to be evaluated:** Number of people with disabilities in the teams, number of adapted sport activities carried out, number of people reached with these activities, impact generated, campaigns to promote and disseminate the values of adapted sport, milestones achieved, etc.

**3- GENDER DIVERSITY:** Initiatives, entities or individuals that promote and encourage the participation of women and the LGTBI + community in sports will be recognized.

**Criteria to be evaluated:** number of women and LGTBI+ community participating in sports activities, campaigns promoting gender diversity in sports, impact of activities, visibility of actions carried out, milestones achieved, etc.

**4-Innovation in sport:** Those developments or adaptations that, through new sports, implements or solutions, promote physical activity, recreation and the integration of different social groups will be recognized. This category will recognize initiatives and technological and social integrations that promote and encourage sports practice and inclusion in education, business, institutions or other areas of society.

**Criteria to be evaluated:** novelty, creativity, entrepreneurship, number of people involved, impact generated, number of followers, milestones achieved, etc.

3. The registration of nominations/applications for the awards in any of the categories is done exclusively online through a form available on the website of the association. ([www.asociacionpromis.org](http://www.asociacionpromis.org)).

4. The deadline for submission of forms will be Wednesday, June 28, 2024 at 23:59h. For international recognition, the deadline for submission of projects will be Friday, July 26, 2024 at 23:59h.

5. Any person can be invited to submit their candidacy in the call and the PROMIS association may invite outstanding initiatives in these categories to participate in the call. To suggest nominations, please send an email to [asociacionpromis@gmail.com](mailto:asociacionpromis@gmail.com) with the contact details of the entity or the person to be nominated.

6. The qualifying Jury is composed of professionals in the field of sports, inclusion, integration, social welfare, and promotion entities, outstanding for their professional performance and values. They are also promoters of inclusive sport. It is made up of five members (plus two representatives of PROMIS, without vote).

7. The Jury will take into account the information presented by the candidates in the application form and the documentation attached to the same form.

8. The Inclusive Sport Awards will recognize 1 winner for each of the 4 categories; in addition to 1 international recognition for inclusive sport.

Prizes will consist of:

- 1 statuette
- The Jury, optionally, may award 1 runner-up in each or any of the categories.

9. The prize shall not be declared void.



10. The communication of the Award to the winning candidate in each category (except international) will be made before the end of July 2024. The official presentation of the award to the winning candidate will take place after this date, foreseeably in October 2024.

11. The jury's decision is final.

13. Participation in this call for entries implies full acceptance of these RULES.

14. All applicants accept the rules of the call, as well as the right of the PROMIS association to reproduce and use their name, surname and image in any promotional activity related to the dissemination of this call and the activity of promotion of inclusive sport carried out by the entity.

#### **TRATAMIENTO DE DATOS:**

The PROMIS Association, in relation to the data processing carried out during the awarding of the prizes, will comply with the provisions of the regulations governing the protection of personal data in force at all times (LOPD).

All personal data provided, as well as any other data that may be provided throughout the relationship between the association and the interested party, will be included in a file, automated or not, PROMIS association, the sole recipient of the data, in order to carry out the management of applications and, where appropriate, of the prizes that may be awarded.

The applicant, in case of providing personal data of third parties, after having informed such persons of the full content of this clause, in the same terms in which the applicant has been informed, undertakes to obtain the express consent of such persons whose data is to be provided, to: provide their personal data to the association for the performance of the data processing provided for in this clause.

The applicant, in the event of any variation in the data provided to the association for processing in accordance with the provisions of this clause, shall notify the association so that the latter may proceed with such modification.

All the data collected, as well as the previous treatments and transfers, are essential for the management of the request.
